1. Honorarium

- No honorarium will be paid for your participation.

2. Confirmation of participation

- You must confirm your participation by replying to the invitation email by the requested deadline.
- In case of no response by the deadline, the Programme Committee reserves the right to replace unconfirmed participants.

3. Declaration of Interest

- All speakers and moderators must declare possible conflicts of interest:
 - When accepting their role.
 - When uploading presentation materials.
 - At the beginning of the session (for moderators/chairpersons).
- A Declaration of Interest (DOI) slide must be included at the start of presentations and displayed to the audience. Speakers are requested to read this slide aloud.

4. Presentations and recordings

- All sessions may be recorded and content may be used by the organisers for educational purposes (abstract book, website, educational dissemination).
- By accepting your role, you authorise the organisers to:
 - Record and use your presentation (slides, videos, audio).
 - Share it as part of congress outputs and educational resources.
 - Translate or adapt the content as necessary.
 - Use your presentation for non-commercial purposes, respecting educational objectives, for up to 20 years.

5. Data privacy

- Your personal data is processed in compliance with French law (Loi Informatique et Libertés) and the RGPD.
- Your data is used strictly for managing the symposium and communications related to the event.
